PARISH PLAN REVIEW – CLLR. MRS. P. LLOYD (& REVIEW GROUP MEMBERS)

Cllr. Mrs. Lloyd handed around the meeting copies of the Group's latest updated version of the Parish Plan Review 2010.

An outline was given of the current situation with the revision to the Plan, which now incorporated requested comments from individuals over a consultation period. Requests for comments had been advertised in the Parish News Magazine.

Cllr. Mrs. Lloyd explained that the Revision could be seen as two separate projects:

- i) An ongoing continuation of the original Parish Plan from 2002
- ii) A totally new type of Plan for action

There followed on much discussion, both on the current state of the Plan with the inclusions supplied by consultees, as well as a proposed Action Plan for the future.

The pages of Action Plans provided by Cllr. Mrs. Lloyd had a fourth column entitled 'Reports by whom to whom', and it was decided that this column should be removed, and that a Revision Date should be inserted.

The following proposal was then made:

“That the Parish Plan Review of 2010 will be handed over to the Parish Council, who will carry out an ongoing review by Working Groups to be established.”

This was unanimously agreed.

This Statement will be placed at the front of the current revision of the Plan, and that no further changes to the revision would be made at this time.

Some sections of the Plan could be updated and reviewed either annually, or every 5 years.
