143/16. Apologies for absence.

144/16. Declaration of interest and written requests for dispensation on agenda items.

Police Report

- No more crimes reported since last month. The recent dwelling theft along Bearwood Lane – Police continue to making house enquiries and support the occupier.

147/16. Planning Applications for comment.

Planning applications recently received:

- 163651 – Land off Sandiford Ploc, Pembridge, Herefordshire.
Proposed erection of 7 dwellings.

Comment: Pembridge Parish Council SUPPORT this application and make the following observations.

- The colour of the house render should be sympathetic in consideration of Pembridge conservation area.
- Improved road measures to upgrade the surface and reinstate the white lining at Bridge Street junction should be considered for the increased road traffic.

- 163146 - Land Adjacent to Luntley Cottage, Pembridge, HR6 9EH.
Erection of an agricultural building for free range egg production, together with associated feed bins, hard standings, attenuation pond and access track. - **SUPPORT**

151/16. S278 priorities for the parish.

The clerk asked councillors to consider further how they would like any section 106/section 278/Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) spent as a priority in the parish. A prepared list can then be forwarded to relevant parties and funds allocated accordingly. A final list was compiled in no preference order.

- Gateways at the brow of the bank before entering the speed limit chicane
- Re instating the verge on East Street opposite chicane, possible kerbing and use of wooden oak bollards.
- White line painting to improve driver awareness of the speed limit at the chicane at East Street
- Gateway signs at west end of village.
- Bridge street white lining.
- Effective signage for Bridge Street
- Contribution towards playground funds and upkeep
- Zig Zags at the school entrance
- Lining/no parking around the market hall
- Pavement repairs
- Bollards on pavements where required.

152/16. Broxwood phone box

Cllr Pace described repairs needed to improve the phone box in Broxwood. After a short discussion, Cllr Purslow offered to provide labour to repair the box. Once repaired PiPs would arrange to paint and refresh. Cllr Pace to ask Broxwood parishioners if they might like to be involved. Cllr Bennetto advised the hinges on the phone box in the village were also damaged. *Clerk to contact to BT to repair.*
