

Hereford Area Plan

The vision for Hereford was displayed at the Courtyard 4,5 & 6th April for public consultation.

It showed ideas how Herefordshire Council were hoping to deliver changes to the city.

The benefits being:

Urban regeneration, new University, new jobs through the enterprise zone, new homes, key infrastructure, better linkage through the city.

Including 10 hectares of employment land made available with plans for new facilities, new police and fire stations, new university and accommodation and further development in the city.

It considered tourism and leisure facilities and confirmed needing to build 6500 homes by 2031.

Transport Plan

The objectives were generally considering movement of traffic around Hereford city.

The Objectives include the city link road, a bypass, reduce congestion, improve connections, health and safety and provide local growth.
